Architect-designer Yossi Friedman of Friedman/McAlpin, New York, will be refurbishing the 50-year-old, two-building, 86-unit **Pancoast Plaza Apartments** in Miami Beach for developer Michael Harvey who will also readopt the building's original name, Helen Mar.

Harvey, a principal in Helen Mar Partners Ltd., paid \$1.4 million for the property to Eugene and Roberta Weiss, Bobby Goodis and Leionel Bosem. The seven-story structure is located on Lake Pancoast Drive, between Collins Avenue and Pinetree Drive. Friedman is also the architectural consultant at The Strand, a new restaurant at the site of a former Miami Beach landmark, The Famous Restaurant.
